Access Overview

This concert performance in an intimate, relaxed setting is blind and low-vision friendly.

How to Experience

This is a concert by Rainbow Chan, a Hong Kong-Australian vocalist, producer, multi-instrumentalist. Her music blends Cantopop, electronic music, Chinese folk laments, and experimental sound. Her songs explore themes of migration, identity, love and loss.

After the concert, audience members will be invited to stay for an open mic karaoke party, hosted by Rainbow Chan.

The concert performance will have an intimate atmosphere, with a bar in the space and audience members free to move around if they need to. Audiences tend to be quiet and attentive as Rainbow Chan shares her songs. People who choose to stay for the karaoke party after can sing if they choose to. This part of the evening will potentially be more noisy, with audience members free to socialize amongst themselves.

The evening will take place on Ming Wong's *Vast Ocean, Boundless Skies* stage, which is an art installation that is part of the "Dream Factory: Cantopop Mandopop 1980s-2000" exhibition at the Chinese Canadian Museum. The installation uses light and laserdics to reflect on the migration of people from Hong Kong to Canada in the 1980s and 90s.

There will be mostly armless folding chairs for audience members, with some seating on couches available.

Length of Performance

The concert is 50 minutes long. Afterwards, audience members are invited to stay for a karaoke party hosted by Rainbow Chan. The concert together with the karaoke will last 120 minutes.

Latecomer & Re-Admission Policies

Latercomers and audience members who exit will be allowed to re-enter at an appropriate time.
