Access Overview

On Feb 7, the show will have ASL-interpretation, and audio description will be available via headset for blind and low-vision audience members.

How to Experience

This is a drag show about testosterone, non-binary and trans experiences. The show is very visual and includes lipsync, dancing and reveals. There are funny, heartwarming and emotional parts to the performance. There are atmospheric slow parts and big party songs.

Length of Performance

60 minutes

Latecomer & Re-Admission Policies

After the show starts, latecomers will be held for 6 minutes, until a safe entry point. After 25 minutes into the performance, latecomers will not be admitted.

Technical Warnings

- This show contains strobe lights and flashing lights throughout, and there are moments of complete darkness
- There is a few loud and sudden music/sounds throughout the performance, and club music is included
- Some set and props are made of latex
- There is use of haze

Detailed Content Notes

- The show contains physical references to sex, verbal references to transphobia
- The performer will wear checkerboard facial makeup
- A display screen will show a series of rolling sentences in red
- The performer will get undressed early in the show and underneath will be wearing a flesh colour muscle body suit
- From the middle of the show, the performer will take off the flesh colour muscle body and be naked until the end
- The performer will pull out 3 long cushioned limbs from the stage
- At the end of the show, the performer will collect and lie on the limbs
